

COVID 19 Guidelines for In Person Service

ENTERING AND EXITING THE SANCTUARY

- All attendees must arrive by 9:45am to ensure there is time to sign in and be seated before live streaming start.
- Enter the Church ONLY through the front doors
- Sign in before entering the Sanctuary/Church.
- Temperature checked at the entrance door (99F or less).
- Wear a MASK during the complete service.
- Hand sanitizer will be made available for usage before entering the Sanctuary.
- Remain three feet of social distancing from any individual(s) who is not of the same household or a caregiver to someone in that household.
- Exit the service ONLY through the door in the foyer, outside of the Pastor office.
- We reserve the right to deny access to the building/church.

MISCELLANEOUS

- The bathrooms will be sanitized after every 20 minutes.
- All meetings and bible study will be virtual.
- The Sanctuary/Church will be sanitized before each service.
- Sanitizer will be located at front entrance and exits.
- The Church will have a limited number of MASKS available at the front entrance.

SERVICE PROCEDURE

- No Choir.
- No Processional.
- No Altar Call/ no kneeling at the altar (Except the person doing invocation).
- There will be NO Hymnal, Bibles or bulletin provided by the Church.
- No socializing inside the Church.
- The service will be limited to one hour (not more than one hour and fifteen minutes on Communion Sunday).
- Virtual (Zoom/Facebook or YouTube) will be an option for Sunday services.

SERVICE PROCEDURE

- No Choir.
- No Processional.
- No Altar Call/ no kneeling at the altar (Except the person doing invocation).
- There will be NO Hymnal, Bibles or bulletin provided by the Church.

COMMUNION

- The Stewardess will hand out the Communion juice sets at the door when you enter the Sanctuary/Church.
- Members are asked to deposit the empty communion juice container into the basket at the exit door.
